




שׁלֵּהָה אֲנִי is the first prayer we say every day. We recite מׁלֹהָה אֲנִי before we say מֹלֹהָה אֲנִי before we begin our morning service. We recite מׁלֹהָה אֲנִי before we even go to the synagogue. With מֹלְהָה אֲנִי we recognize God's place in our lives the moment we wake up. מֹלְהָה אֲנִי we say upon awakening -- I give thanks to God for returning my soul to me.
