

We began the אָמִירָה, our central prayer, with three blessings of praise. We then went on to make requests, to ask things from God for our community. Now we conclude the אַמִירָה with three blessings of thanksgiving: In our first blessing of thanksgiving we pray that our blessings be received. In our second blessing of thanksgiving, we say thank you for what has been done for us and for what is yet to come.

Our final עַּמִירָה blessing, שְׁלוֹם רָב blessing, שְׁלוֹם הְיּשׁ, is really both a thank you and a request. We ask for the blessing of שְׁלוֹם רָב abundant peace and well being. And we thank and praise the "One who blesses Israel with שִׁלוֹם."



לוֹם רָב is the blessing for שְׁלוֹם יְנָ that is recited at the end of the evening אַמִירְה. There is a different version of this prayer, שִׁים שְׁלוֹם, for the morning אַמִירָה. Morning or evening, our request is not for us alone. We ask for שְׁלוֹם for the whole community.






