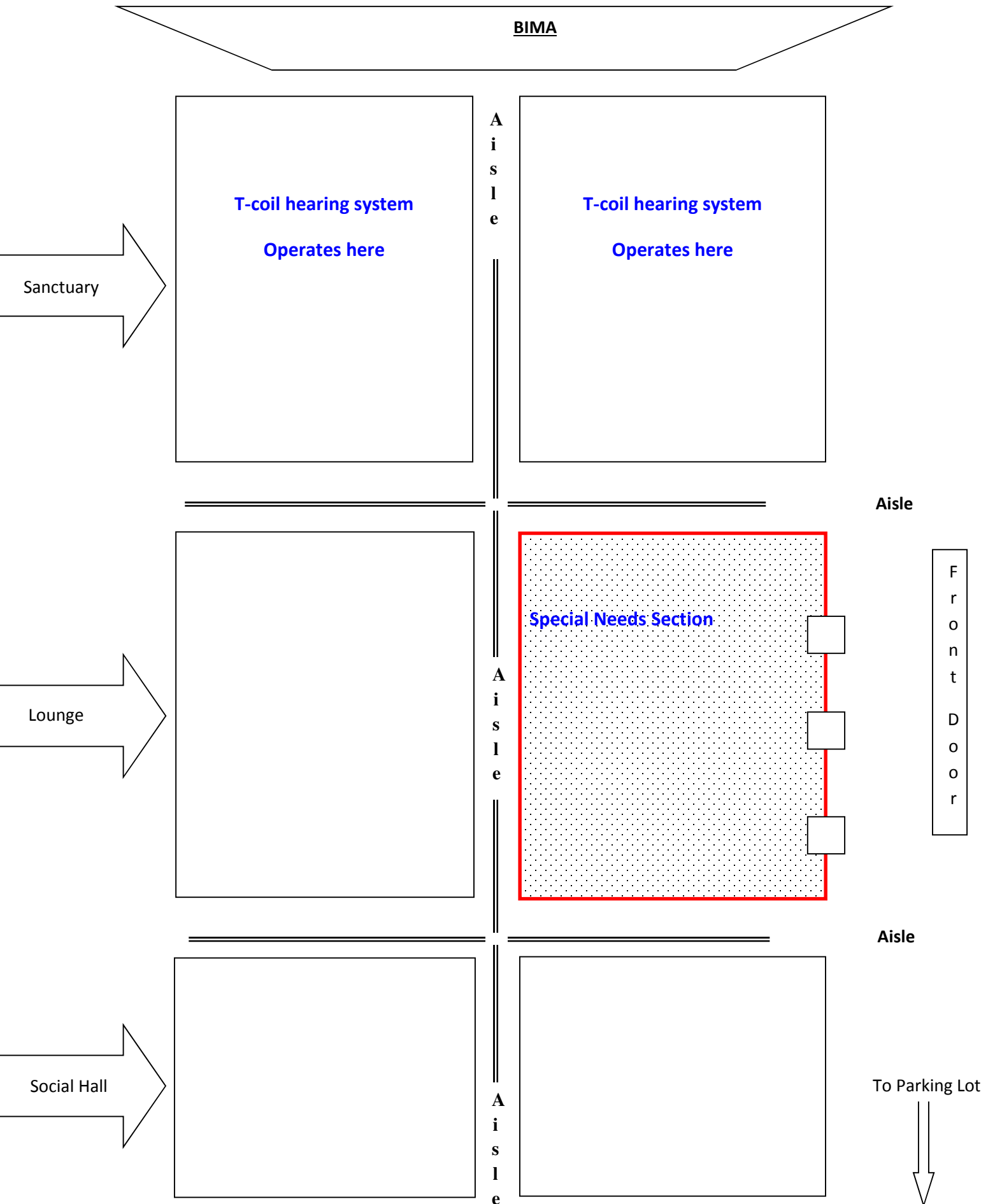

The Congregation Solel approved policy for special seating is:

- Special requirements seating will be in a designated area and not throughout the Sanctuary. **It is the area marked with special stanchions**, just inside the columns near the front entrance. **(see map on reverse side)**
- Special requirements seating will apply to the named individual and up to 3 additional persons. Please reserve only the number of seats you will need. **Reserved seats not occupied 30 minutes before services will be released. If you know in advance you will not be able to attend, please let us know to make the seats available to other congregants.**
- Special requirements will focus on mobility to help ensure that these individuals have improved access and an enhanced ability to evacuate the building in case of emergency. Of course, there will continue to be accommodations for those coming to worship with visual or hearing impairments—but not special seating. The Sanctuary is now equipped with the T-coil hearing enhancement system, check with your audiologist regarding your devices. A limited number of auxiliary devices are available.
